All our contractors will be given adequate supervision, information, instructions and training as is necessary to carry out their duties on behalf of TMC Security Services Ltd

We will identify significant hazards and plan for their elimination, reduction and control by conducting risk assessments at regular intervals, the results of which will be communicated to our contractors.

We will ensure that the resources necessary to achieve the objectives of this policy are made available.

An annual review of this policy and associated procedures will be carried out to ensure their continued effectiveness and where necessary amended. Any amendments will be brought to the attention of all persons that need to know.
